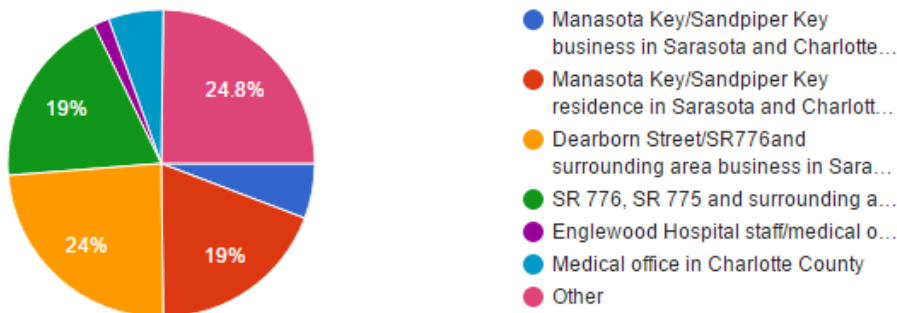

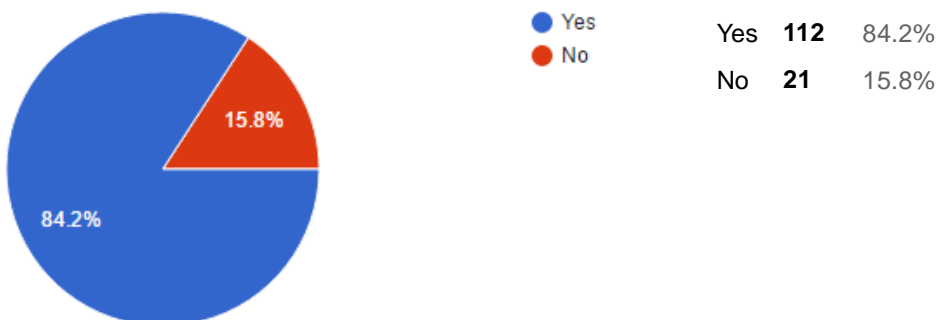

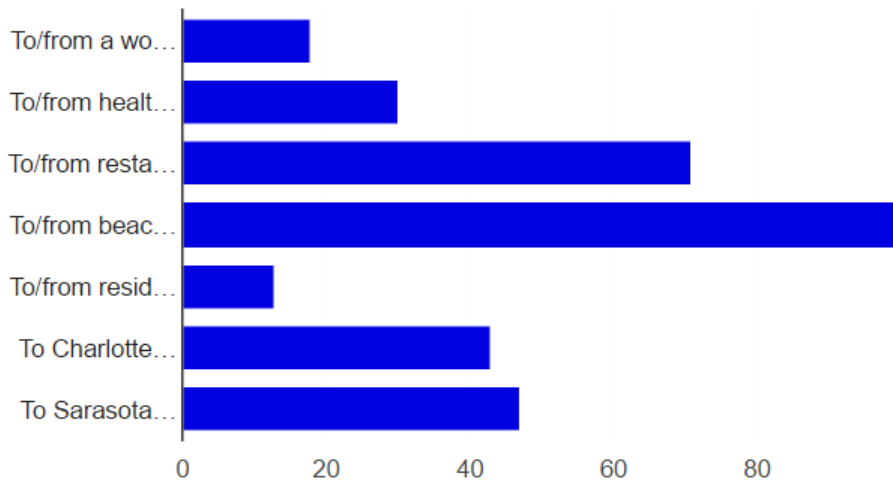

3. Do you own or are able to drive a vehicle when needed?

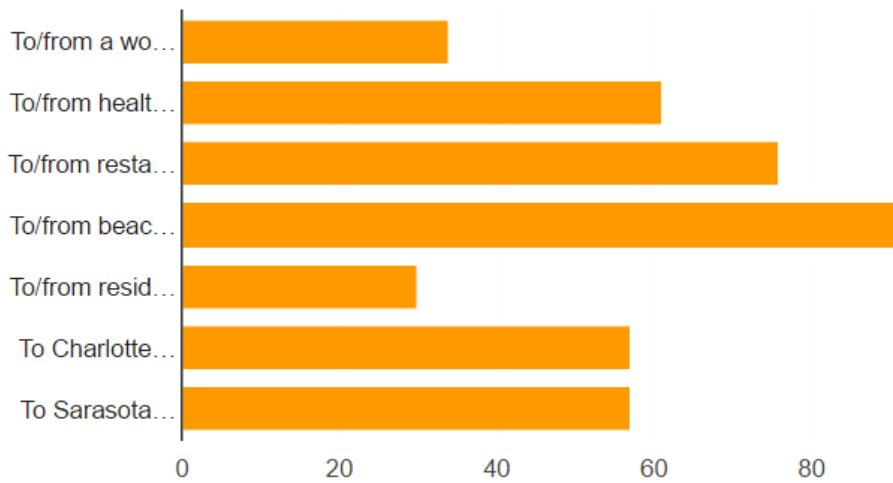

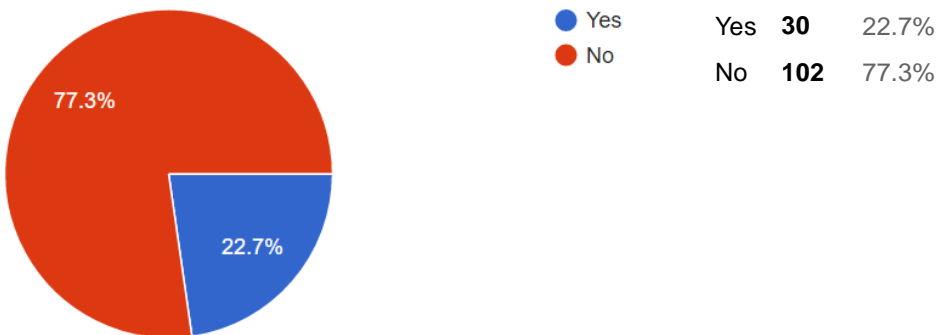

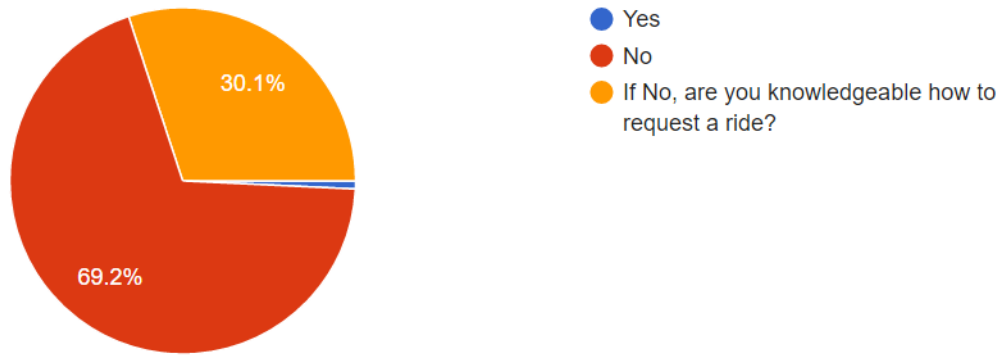
