- Class size is limited to 20 students. Tuition is \$500 per student.
- **I understand full tuition will be due upon my acceptance unless other arrangements are approved in advance.**
- If you are selected for the Class, you are making a commitment to the program and to your classmates to attend each month's field trip day. A class member can miss up to two (2) classes and still graduate. If any classes are beyond two, it is a requirement to make up the classes, with a future Leadership Class, in order to officially graduate.
- Participants are selected through an anonymous process. Try to avoid revealing your identity through your answers to the questions.

Please provide your answers in a format that does not display your name or the name of your business. Be sure to answer every question completely.

Number your answers to correspond with the questions and then **attach your answers with this form for submission.**

- (1) Tell us about yourself, such as where you live, employment history, extracurricular activities, education and special interests.
- (2) During your business career, what do you consider your most significant contribution or achievement?
- (3) List, in order of importance to you, as many as five community, civic, professional, business, or other organizations in which you are or have been a member, and include number of years as a member and any offices held.
- (4) What types of volunteer activities would you like to become involved with in the future?
- (5) Describe how you have demonstrated a leadership role in your personal and/or professional life.
- (6) Describe one important personal or professional goal you hope to attain within the next five years.
- (7) What do you consider to be your major strengths and qualifications for participation in the Leadership Englewood program and describe your reason for wanting to participate in Leadership Englewood.
- (8) What benefits to the community do you feel are likely to result from your participation in Leadership Englewood?
